This Policy defines how we collect and use any personal information for the duration of your use of this Site in line with all Data Protection Laws. It also describes the different types of cookies and similar technologies that may be applied on the Vision Blue Solutions Site and associated subdomains.

What information do we collect about you?

We collect information on you when you visit our website, submit a contact form and login to secure areas of the website.

This website uses [Google Analytics](#), a web analytics service provided by Google.

Google Analytics sets a cookie to which allows us to evaluate your use of this website and compile reports for activity on the website. This enables us to continuously improve our websites user experience.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a Site. Cookies are then sent back to the originating Site on each subsequent visit, or to another Site that recognises that cookie.

Cookies are useful because they allow a Site to recognise a user’s device. You can find more information about cookies at:

Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently remembering your preferences, and generally improve your website experience.

Your web browser will then send these cookies back to the website on each visit. The purpose of this is to collect standard internet log and visitor behaviour information.
